### How much does it cost?

We receive government funding that meets some of our ongoing costs. We ask for a voluntary donation of \$6 per day (or \$4 for a morning session) to help to maintain the buildings, purchase resources, equipment and pay ongoing expenses. All children receive 30 hours ECE free per week.

### Are the teachers trained?

Yes. All of our teachers are 100% trained, registered and supported by senior teachers.

### How do I enrol my child?

Children can be enrolled from 2 years of age. You are welcome to come and visit, and fill in an enrolment form. Please bring a copy of your child's birth certificate and immunisation record.
