How much does it cost?

We receive government funding that meets some of our ongoing costs. Requested donations are based on the following scale: \$6 per part day session or \$8 for a full day. Donations help to maintain the buildings, purchase resources and equipment and pay ongoing expenses. All children receive up to 30 hours ECE free per week.

Are the teachers trained?

Yes. All of our teachers are 100% trained, registered and supported by senior teachers.

How do I enrol my child?

Children can be enrolled from two years of age. You are welcome to come and visit, and fill in an enrolment form. Please bring a copy of your child's birth certificate and immunisation record.
